Article 4:

Are you in favor of the adoption of Amendment No. 3 as proposed by the planning board for the town zoning ordinance as follows:

(1) amend article 3, Definitions, and article 19, Adult Business Establishments, to replace the term "adult business establishment" with the term "sexually oriented business";
